Northwest Narwhals compete at MAC Fall Fest Invitational

On October 16-18, 2015 thirteen swimmers attended the first meet of the season at the MAC Fall Fest competing at the Markham Pan Am Pool under the direction of Head Coach David Iwanyszyn.

In the 12 year old girls division Ilana Mironsky ranked 1st in the 200 Back, 2nd in the 100 Back, 3rd in the 200 Breast, 7th in the 100 Breast, 13th in the 100 Free and 17th in the 50 Free cutting time off every swim.

In the 13 year old girls division Alyssa Bossio has outstanding swims with 1st in the 100 Back and 200 Back, 2nd in the 100 Free and 100 Breast, 3rd in the 50 Free and a 5th in the 200 IM.

In the 14 year old girls division Emma Moorhouse swam her first 800 Free finishing 12th overall along with a 12th in the 100 Free. She also finished 13th in the 200 Breast, 15th in the 50 Free, 17th in the 100 Breast, 18th in the 400 Free and 20th in the 200 Free.

In the Boys 14 year old division Tyler Trottier finished 3rd in the 100 Breast, 6th in the 200 Breast, 15th in the 100 Back and 100 Fly finishing up with 18th in the 200 Free.

In the 15 and over girls division Brittney Felix lead the group with a strong performance ranking 3rd in the 100 Fly; 5th in the 200 IM, 100 Back and 100 Free; 6th in the 50 Free and 8th in the 200 Back. Morgan LaBelle swam hard for a 10th in the 200 Breast and 200 Back; 11th in the 400 Free; 12th in the 800 Free; 13th in the 200 IM and 200 Free; and 15th in the 400 IM. Riley James had all personal bests with a 18th in the 400 Free, 19th in the 200 Back, 20th in the 50 Free, 22nd in the 800 Free, 24th in the 100 Back and 26th in the 200 Free. Madelyn Ross had good results with a 15th in the 200 Back, 20th in the 100 Back, 26th in the 100 Free, 29th in the 800 Free, 33rd in the 50 Free, 35th in the 100 Breast and 40th in the 200 IM. Heather Eyben held her own resulting in 25th in the 100 Free, 7th in the 50 Free, 32nd in both the 800 Free and 100 Breast, 39th in the 100 Back, 47th in the 200 IM and 48th in the 200 Free.

In the boys 15 and over division Lawson Mironsky lead the group with a pair of 7th place finishes in the 800 Free and 200 Breast; 9th in the 100 Breast, 11th in the 100 Fly, 13th in the 100 Free, 14th in the 400 Free and 17th in the 50 Free. Eric Osala kept

focused to finish 11th in the 200 Breast, 18th in the 400 IM, 23rd in the 100 Breast and Fly, 24th in the 100 Free and 27th in the 200 IM. Matthew Dafoe swam well to finish 18th in the 100 Free, 21st in the 100 Breast, 25th in the 50 Free, 26th in the 100 Back and 28th in the 200 IM. Cameron Mackey had excellent showing with 11th in the 800 Free, 18th in the 100 Breast, 20th in the 100 Free, 22nd in the 100 Back, 23rd in the 50 Free, 30th in the 200 IM and 33rd in the 200 IM.

Next up the team splits up to head to the ?????? in Toronto and Kenora for the KSS Open on November 7 and 8th.
